**CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK....**

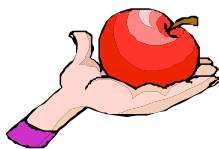

**Q is for QUESTIONS**

Find out what is on your child's mind by asking questions.

--Ask specific questions. Your child is more likely to have an answer to *Who did you play with at recess?* than *How was your day?*

--Ask open-ended questions. *How did you do that?* or *What would happen if...?* questions will yield more information than questions that can be answered in a word or two.

--Help your child develop critical thinking skills by responding to his or her questions with questions. *Copyright Educationworld.com*
