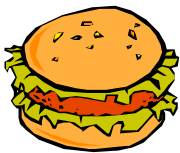

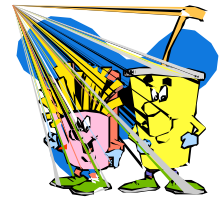

Please note that all balances which you may still have with St. Emydius School such as tuition, fundraisers, late a.m. and pickup fees, etc. must be paid in full by

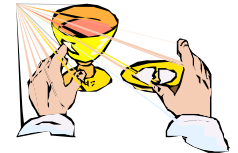
