Thank you for your continued support of St. Emydius School.

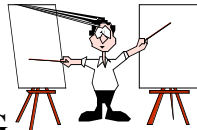

**ST. EMYDIUS SCHOOL FESTIVAL.....**

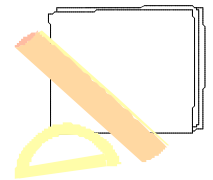

The last day to return your St. Emydius School Festival Raffle tickets and money is Thursday, April 29.

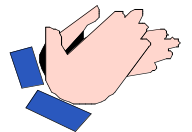
