INTERPRETATION OF GRADES

A student merits the Grade "A" or "A-" when the student;

- Presents an excellent quality of work.
- Consistently does more than he/she is required.
- Follows directions and completes all assignments.
- Takes an active part in discussions.
- Is prompt, thorough and neat in work.

A student merits the Grade "B" or "B-" when the student:

- Presents a good quality of work.
- Frequently does more work than is required.
- Is careful in following directions and completing assignments.
- Is prompt, neat, thorough, and usually accurate in all work.

A student merits the Grade "C" or "C-" when the student:

- Presents average quality of work.
- Does what is required.
- Is attentive when following directions and completing all assignments.
- Has average neatness and accuracy in work.

A student merits the Grade "D" when the student:

- Presents poor quality of work.
- Usually does less than is required.
- Is often inattentive in following directions and completing assignments.
- Is careless in preparation and presentation of assignments.

A student merits the Grade "F" when the student:

- Fails to do the required work.
- Is inattentive in class.
- Is lacking the required skills.
- Presents incomplete assignments frequently.
