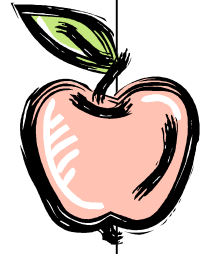

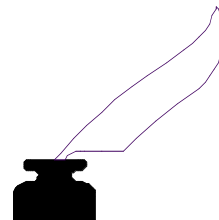
Thank you to all the mothers who helped Miss Williams with the new social studies books. Your help is greatly appreciated.
